was one of the first African American children to go to an all white primary school. She helped to end racial segregation in schools.



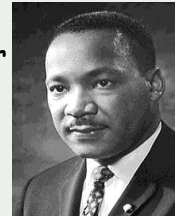
Mary Seacole

David Attenborough

is an environmental campaigner.



Emily Davison

was a suffragette. She fought for women to be able to vote.



Malala Yousafzai

was awarded the nobel peace prize in 2014. she campaigns for the rights of girls to go to school.



Vocabulary

Segregation	The practice of separating people according to groups, especially racial groups.
Discrimination	To treat people differently because of their race, age, or gender.
Equality	To be treated equally and fairly.
Freedom	The state of being free to act or move as one wishes.
Racism	The unfair treatment of people based on the opinion that one race is better than another race or races.
Campaigner	person who takes part in organized activities that are intended to change something in society
Significant	sufficiently great or important to be worthy of attention.
Herbal Remedies	Treatments for common illnesses made by using different parts of plants.
Prejudice	Hatred or unfair treatment toward a person or group without cause or reason.
Sanitation	The practice of keeping the public healthy by providing clean living conditions.
Suffragette	a woman seeking the right to vote through organized protest.
Boycott	to refuse to buy, use, or go to, in order to make a protest or bring about a change

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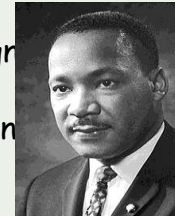
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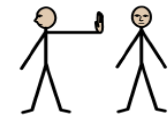

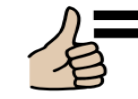
