

Key learning

1	Jesus grew up with Mary and Joseph in Nazareth. In the New Testament he is called Jesus of Nazareth
2	The New Testament contains the story of Jesus and the early church. These stories of Jesus are taken from the four Gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke and John.
3	Jesus came to John the Baptist while he was baptising people in the River Jordan. John baptised Jesus and after this had happened a white dove flew on him and a voice of heaven was heard saying "This is my son. I am very pleased with him."
4	In the Sermon of the Mount, Jesus taught his followers the Lord's prayer and told them several parables. The sermon also contained the Beatitudes and Jesus' teachings about God's laws, which he expected his followers to uphold.
5	The Beatitudes are how Jesus explains to his followers what kinds of human lives are blessed by God. According to Jesus, God gives his blessings to people who are humble, people who make peace and people who show mercy to others.
6	Followers of Jesus believe he performed seven miracles. 1 Turning water into wine (John 2:1-12) 2 Healing the Nobleman's son (John 4:46-54) 3 Healing the Man at the pool (John 5:1-11) 4 Feeding of the 5000 (John 6:1-15) 5 Jesus walking on water (John 6:16-21) 6 Healing a man born blind (John 9:1-12) 7 The resurrection of Lazarus (John 11)
7	Jesus used parables to help people understand the things he taught. The word parable comes from the Greek words 'bole' meaning throwing and 'para' meaning alongside. Examples of parables are Parables of the Good Samaritan and the Parable of the Prodigal son
8	Transfiguration means transformed. Jesus was transformed into a glorious image in which his face shone like the sun and his clothes became as white as light

The Life and Teachings of Jesus

Vocabulary / Important people

1	Jesus of Nazareth	Jesus was born c 6-4BCE and died c 30 CE and was regarded by Christians as the incarnation of God
2	John The Baptist	John The Baptist was a preacher and Jesus' cousin. John baptised Jesus in the Jordan River.
3	Lazarus	Lazarus was a friend of Jesus who he brought back to life after he died.
4	Baptism	Baptism takes place in water. Christians believe that John baptised Jesus and that people go under the water they believe Jesus died for them and when you are above the water they believe it shows them that God brought Jesus back to life
5	The Lord's Prayer	The Lord's Prayer (Matthew 6:5-13) is the most important Christian prayer. It helps Christians to have a deeper understanding of the Bible, the life of Jesus and Christian teachings.
6	Disciples	The Disciples were the followers of Jesus: Peter, Andrew, James, Nathanael, Matthew, Thomas, James son of Alphaeus, Simon, Judas the Greater and Judas Iscariot
7	Miracles	The miracles of Jesus are miraculous deeds attributed to Jesus found in the Bible.
8	Parables	A parable is a simple story used to show moral or spiritual lessons told by Jesus in the Gospels.
9	Resurrection	The raising of the dead

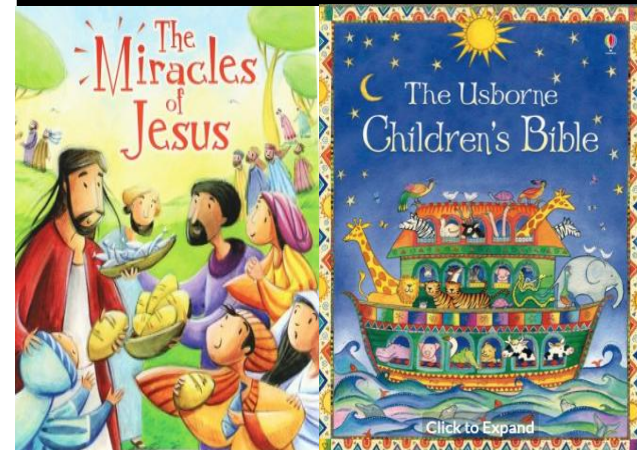
Big Question
